### PLYMOUTH PHIL KICKS OFF NEW YEAR WITH THE MUSIC OF JAMES BOND

PLYMOUTH, MA —The **Plymouth Philharmonic Orchestra** kicks off the new year with the perfect musical martini - *Shaken, Not Stirred: Music of James Bond*. Conductor **Steven Karidoyanes** and *the Phil* join forces with the acclaimed **Jeans 'n Classics** band to perform iconic music from James Bond films on January 28 & 29 at Memorial Hall. Audiences will enjoy hearing hits such as “Skyfall,” “Nobody Does it Better,” “For Your Eyes Only,” and “Live and Let Die” with full lush strings and bright horns performed live by professional orchestra musicians.

“Who doesn’t get super excited when the signature Bond theme roars off the screen of these action-packed movies? I know I do, and the excellent musicians of our orchestra will play these film score excerpts live!” says Karidoyanes. “I’ve always been thrilled by the Bond music catalogue. There isn’t enough concert time for us to play every song from every Bond film but, in the couple of hours we’ll have on stage together with our guest artists, we’ll perform most of them — and I can’t wait!”

Alongside our orchestra musicians, the concerts also feature lead vocalists **Rique Franks** and **David Blamires**, as well as members of the Jeans 'n Classics band. While not a tribute act, Jeans 'n Classics faithfully interprets the music of legendary rock and pop albums, artists, and film scores with their own signature flair.

There are two performances: **Saturday, January 28 at 7:30 PM** and **Sunday, January 29 at 3 PM**. Both performances are at **Plymouth Memorial Hall** at 83 Court Street/Route 3A, Plymouth, MA.

Individual ticket prices range from \$25 to \$100. Advance tickets can be purchased online at [plymouthphil.org](http://plymouthphil.org) or by calling 508-746-8008.

A free shuttle will run to and from Memorial Hall beginning 60 minutes before the concert from the parking area of Hotel 1620. The shuttle will return to the parking area following the concert.
