GRAMMY AWARD WINNER, TIME FOR THREE, TO PERFORM BENEFIT CONCERT IN PLYMOUTH

PLYMOUTH, MA — Recently honored with two GRAMMY awards, classical-crossover sensation **Time for Three** performs a benefit concert for the **Plymouth Philharmonic Orchestra** on **Saturday, April 29, at Memorial Hall.**

“Time for Three is renowned for its energetic and charismatic performances,” explains *Phil* Executive Director **Kim Corben**. “We are thrilled to promote this very talented group. Instead of *being* the performers in this concert, we are the *presenters* — with 100% of ticket sales going back to *the Phil* as a fundraiser. It will be an excellent show and a fun addition to our regular concert season.”

Having graced the stages of **Carnegie Hall, The Kennedy Center, and The Royal Albert Hall**, Time for Three has earned praise from across all major media, from NPR and NBC to *The Wall Street Journal* and *The Washington Post*. **Sir Simon Rattle**, music director of the **London Symphony Orchestra**, proclaimed that Time for Three’s members are “benevolent monsters, monsters of ability and technique surely. But also conveyors of an infectious joy that I find both touching and moving.”

Time For Three comprises two violinists, Nicolas “Nick” Kendall and Charles Yang, and bassist Ranaan Meyer; all three musicians are also vocalists, a defining feature of the group. The trio rose to acclaim with awe-inspiring classical repertoire, including Bach’s *Chaconne in Winter*, heartfelt standards such as “Stand by Me” and “Hallelujah,” along with original pop-inflected compositions. Their collaborations are just as diverse, having worked with **Ben Folds, Branford Marsalis, Joshua Bell, Aoife O’Donovan, Natasha Bedingfield,** and **Arlo Guthrie**. The group appeared on ABC’s *Dancing With The Stars* and won an Emmy for *Time For Three In Concert*, produced by PBS. Time for Three’s last release, *Letters for the Future*, was recorded with **The Philadelphia Orchestra**, and it skyrocketed to the Billboard Top 10 Classical Recordings chart. In February, the album received a GRAMMY award for Best Classical Instrumental Solo.

The Plymouth Phil is honored to present Time for Three in concert on **Saturday, April 29, 7 PM at Plymouth Memorial Hall** located at 83 Court Street.
